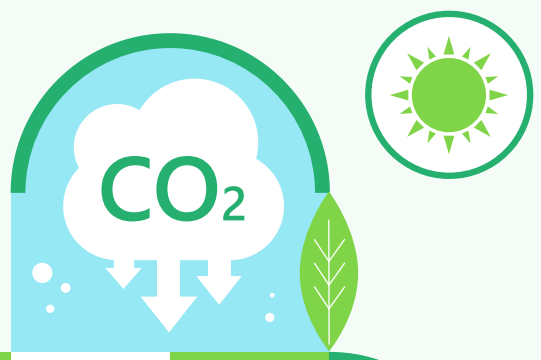
Product Excellence

- Customer complaints on Food Safety Tier 1/ Zero tolerance of raw materials and finished products / Drug residue in finished products - No anomalies
- 18 patents were obtained in 2025
- A total of 23 products obtained Health Food Certification labels
- 2 products obtained A.A. certification, bringing the cumulative total to 34 certified products
- 2 products were selected as senior-friendly products, bringing the cumulative total to 27 products
- 6 products obtained medals from the A.A. Taste Award, a global assessment of pure taste
- 3 products won the Taiwan Food Technology Innovation Product Awards
- 5 products won the Monde Selection World Quality Award
- 4 products obtained the ITI Superior Taste Award, including 3 products that received three-star awards
- 2 animal welfare egg products obtained the CAS Taiwan Excellent Agricultural Products Label and the TAP Traceability Agricultural Product Label



Environmental Sustainability

- Yangmei General Plant won the silver medal of the 2025 Energy Saving Benchmark Award by MOEA
- Won the Private Enterprise Green Procurement Excellence Award by the Ministry of Environment for 12 consecutive years
- Our total green procurement amounted to NT\$1.956 billion in 2025, an increase of 24.54% compared to the previous year
- In 2025, we remained committed to improving the output rate of raw materials, achieving 97.89% for soybeans, 96.51% for tea leaves, and 96.54% for fresh milk
- In 2025, total renewable energy generation amounted to approximately 792,207 kWh, with total renewable energy sold reaching 703,055 kWh
- Scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gas emission intensity was reduced by 7.62% in 2025



Social Inclusion

- The "August 9 Waist Measurement Day" received responses from 12 county and city leaders, 22 county and city health bureau directors, and 46 celebrities via Facebook posts, reaching a total of 13.14 million Facebook fans. The event also guided the public to self-assess their metabolic syndrome risk using ibon app, with 11,154 people participating. Additionally, 19,380 people participated via the National Health Insurance Quick Access App. A total of 200,000 measuring scales were distributed with salads, with the Group distributing a total of 522,000 pieces
- A total of 8 preventive medicine seminars were held this year, attracting 3,144 participants with an attendance rate of over 90% across all sessions, 5 of which were fully booked
- Launched the "Half Your Plate with Fruits and Vegetables for Guaranteed Health" campaign, which encouraged participants to ensure fruits and vegetables made up half of their meals. The event garnered 52 media reports, and the video explaining healthy plate concept reached 270,000 views
- "Muscle check-in, protein delivered" was held in Hualien, leading seniors in aerobics to build muscle, and distributing nearly 25,000 bottles of soy milk and cow's milk after the workout
- Scholarships and grants for outstanding university students from impoverished families, scholarships for disadvantaged new immigrant students, talent development programs in rural schools, scholarships and grants for after-school tutoring programs, and disability empowerment projects benefited approximately 1,793 students, 25 schools, 19 after-school tutoring programs, and 6 disability organizations in 2025
- A total of \$4.6 million was invested in sponsoring teachers and meals for after-school tutoring programs in remote areas, benefiting 19 after-school tutoring classes; dairy products were provided for school lunches in 406 schools, benefiting 12,733 disadvantaged students
- Promoted a senior dining program across 30 community locations, benefiting 1,509 senior citizens
- Donated \$4.1 million in supplies to the social affairs bureaus of 20 county and city governments, benefiting approximately 29,760 households and 119,040 individuals. \$8.2 million in emergency relief funds were provided to families in need across Taiwan, benefiting a total of 818 households and approximately 3,272 individuals
